- Begin February 2005?

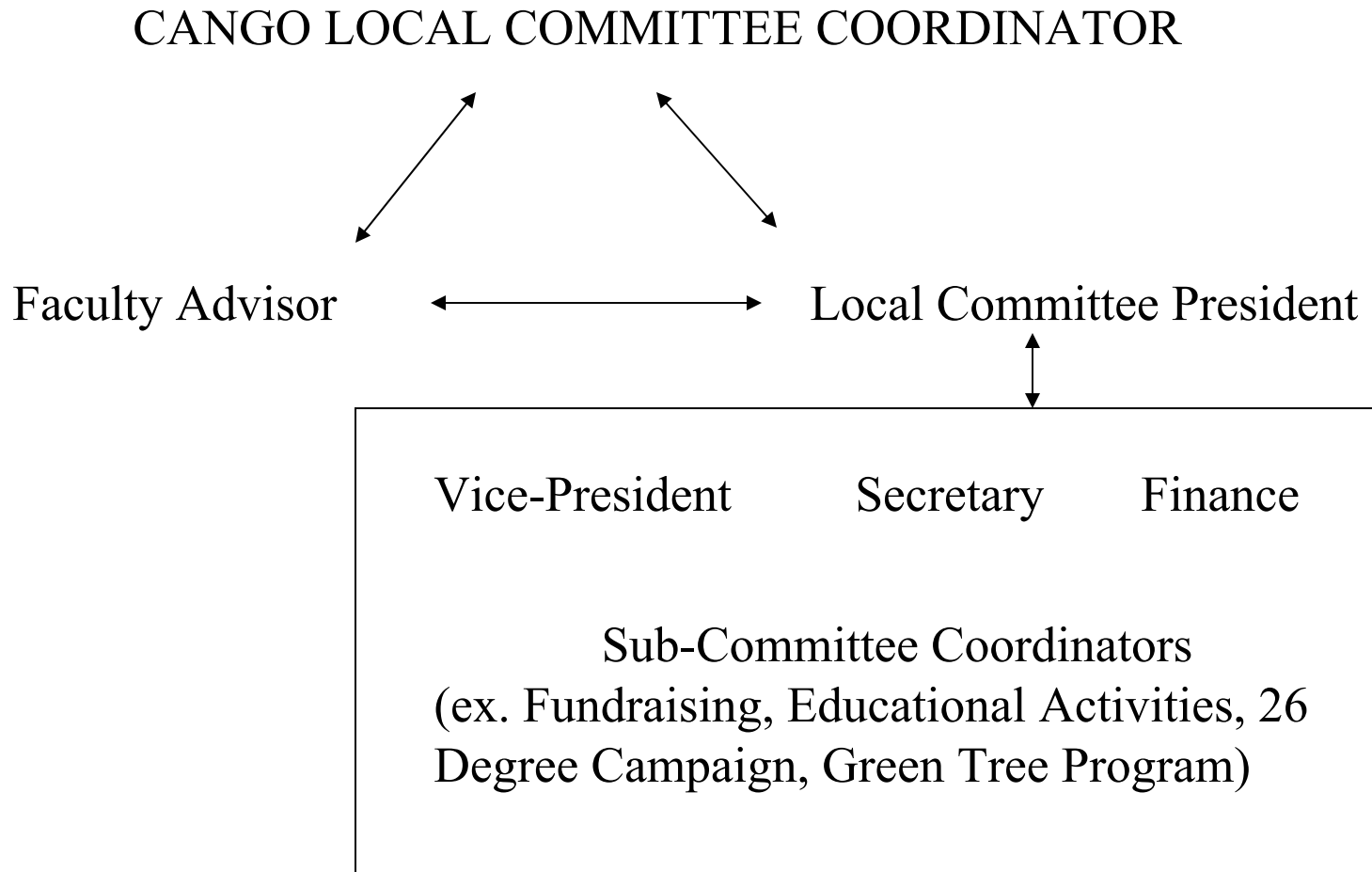
# Outcomes

2. Increased understanding of social issues in China.
3. Increased opportunities for students to be actively involved in development issues in China and raising awareness on social issues to other community members.
4. Increased social responsibility as a result of student participation and awareness promoted through the CANGO Local Committees.
5. Increased awareness of CANGO and its projects.
